The following application for admission to the Honours programme will be considered on receipt of the following:

- Two** completed copies of Application Form U. 24 SP 4
- One** completed copy of Nelson Mandela University General Admission Form or Online application
- Two** completed copies of your **academic record** (i. e., a copy of a computer printout of your most recent official examination results)
- Two** completed **referee reports** (to be handed in by referees)
- Two** certified **copies** of your **identity document**
- One** typed autobiography (No more than 2 -3 pages)
- One** copy of curriculum vitae

No other original documents should be forwarded at this stage. **The closing date for applications for admission to the 2022 Honours programme is 02 August 2021. Please be mindful of postal and courier time scheduling. NO late applications will be accepted or processed.**

### **Selection process for 2022:**

**Admission criteria:** 65% average on psychology modules (calculated by adding ALL core psychology modules from 1st – 3rd year and divide by the number of modules added).

### **Selection Process:**

**Phase I:** Successful candidates are applicants who, at this stage in the selection process, have met the admission criteria (65% average) and are short-listed. These applicants will be invited to a Departmental selection test.

**Phase II:** Short-listed candidates will be invited to a selection test. The content that the test will cover will be provided. The content area of the test will focus on research design and methodology, as well as understanding of core psychological theories and writing skills.

**Phase III:** The top 40 scoring students will be short-listed for the 2022 intake. However, final acceptance into the programme will be dependent on the successful completion of your undergraduate degree as well as maintaining the admission criteria (65%).

**Feedback:** All applicants will be informed of the outcome of the selection process, by means of a final acceptance letter. Please note: the Department does not provide feedback to candidates beyond the outcome of the selection process. We do NOT provide feedback to parents, siblings, friends, colleagues, family relatives etc. This is based on the large number of applicants we receive yearly (200+ applications processed for the 2021 class).

**Please note that incomplete applications WILL NOT be considered.**
